

PATTERN & NOTES

Hdc Border

Rnd 1: sl st in upper corner space to attach yarn to project.

ch 1, hdc in the same st you just sl st into.

Make 1 hdc in each st and [hdc, ch 3, hdc] in each corner.

To work the sides of the blanket, make 1 hdc in the side of

beginning or ending with a sc or hdc.


Make 2 hdc in the side of rows beginning or ending with


a dc, ch 2 or ch 3.

NOTES & REMINDER

Rnd 2: ch 1, hdc in each st around, [hdc, ch 3, hdc] in every
ch 3 corner space. End rnd 2 by making an hdc, ch 3
and then sI stitching into the first hdc of round.
Rnd 3: Repeat rnd 2. Ending rnd 3 by making a full corner
then sI stitching into the first hdc of round.
Rnd 4: Repeat rnd 2. Ending rnd 4 by making a full corner
then one more hdc before sl stitching into the first hdc.
Rnd 5: Repeat rnd 2. Ending rnd 5 by making a full corner
then one more hdc in the next 2 sts before sl stitching into
the first hdc.
When you have finished making your border rounds tie off.
Weave in your ends.
Abbreviations:
ch = chain st(s) = stitch(es)
sc = Single Crochet dc = Double Crochet
