

Crochet Stitch



Circle-To-Square Granny Square

Magic Ring, Ch. 2, or Chain 4 slip stitch in first chain

How To Begin

Pattern: _____

Rnd 1: Chain 3 (counts as your first Dc St) Make 11 Dc stitches in the circle.

Skip the chain 3 and Slip Stitch into the first Dc stitch of Rnd 1.

Rnd 2: Chain 3 (counts as your first Dc St) Make one more Dc stitch in the same
stitch you slip stitched into to close round 1.

Inc Dc (or make 2 Dc stitches) in each stitch space around. (Total 24 sts)

End round 2 by skipping of chain 3 and slip stitching into the first Dc St.

Rnd 3: Chain 3 (counts as your first Dc St) Make one more Dc stitch in the same stitch you slip stitched into to close round 1. Make 1 Dc in the next stitch space. Repeat (Inc Dc, then one Dc) around. (Total 36 sts)
End round 3 by skipping over chain 3 and slip stitching into the first Dc St.

Round 3 is the last round of the circle. You can tie off here and change colors if you would like to. Or continue on to round 4 where we begin the square shape.

Rnd 4: Chain 3 (counts as your first Dc St) Make one more Dc stitch in the same stitch you just slip stitched into. Chain 1.
*Make 2 Dc stitches in the next stitch space.
Make one Hdc stitch in the next 2 stitch spaces.
Make one Sc stitch in the next 3 stitch spaces.
Make one Hdc stitch in the next 2 stitch spaces.*
Corner: Make 2 Dc stitches in the next stitch space, chain 1, make 2 Dc in following stitch space.
Repeat pattern around ending with the last 2 Hdc stitches.
Slip stitch in the top of the first Dc stitch to close round 4.

Rnd 5: Slip stitch to the next chain 1 space. Chain 3 (counts as your first Dc St)
Make one more Dc in the same chain 1 space. Chain 1.
Make 2 more Dc stitches in this same chain 1 space. This is your corner.
Work one Dc stitch in each stitch space across to next chain 1 space.
There should be 11 Dc stitches between each chain 1 space.
In each chain 1 space make (2 Dc, chain 1, 2 Dc)
Repeat around ending round 5 by slip stitching into the first Dc stitch.

Rnd 6: Slip stitch to the next chain 1 space. Chain 3 (counts as your first Dc St)

Make one more Dc in the same chain 1 space. **Chain 2.**

Make 2 more Dc stitches in this same chain 1 space. This is your corner.

Work one Dc stitch in each stitch space across to next chain 1 space.

There should be 15 Dc stitches between each chain 1 space.

In each chain 1 space make (2 Dc, chain 2, 2 Dc)

Repeat around ending round 6 by slip stitching into the first Dc stitch.

If you would like to make more rounds just repeat round 6.

Cut yarn, Tie Off, Weave in your ends.

Your Granny Square is complete!

Abbreviations

Ch = Chain

Sc = Single Crochet

Hdc = Half Double Crochet

Dc = Double Crochet

Sl St = Slip Stitch

St(s) = Stitch(es)

Rnd = Round

Inc = Increase or make 2 stitches in same stitch space.
